

UKIED Standard Outcome Benchmarking Descriptors (SOBDs)

UKIED **Standard Outcome Benchmarking Descriptors (SOBDs)** are used as an evaluative tool in reaching determinations in the UKIED charter mark assessment and accreditation process, learning solution evaluations and the BAME Mental Health Diverse Cymru Certification external verification process. See below for the key judgment descriptors. More detailed information is available to organisations registering to undertake either the UKIED charter marks or the BAME Mental Health Diverse Cymru Certification Scheme.

Good – Area of consistent demonstrable **best practice** consistent with the stated aims and learning outcomes of the Cultural Competency Education Programme (CCEP). Additionally, endorsed by a minimum of 75% of participants.

Satisfactory – Area of consistent demonstrable **effective practice** consistent with the stated aims and learning outcomes of the CCEP, which with minor modification would be considered consistent with best practice. Additionally, endorsed by at least 60% of participants.

Unsatisfactory – Area of demonstrable inconsistent **ineffective practice** not consistent with the stated aims and learning outcomes of the CCEP. Additionally, endorsed by fewer than 50% of participants.
